SUSPENSION OF CAMPAIGN AND BID FOR MP IN WASSA EAST

My decision to contest as an MP for Wassa East was not to come and enrich myself but an opportunity to help the people but most of the people I am sacrificing to help alleviate from poverty, joblessness and dependences of many kind are not ready for the change I want to bring to them. Recently, I commissioned a private consultant to conduct a survey in the Wassa East Constituency to gauge public opinion on electing an independent MP. Finally, I want to extend my heartfelt apologies to those who trusted me and had high hopes of seeing me as their next MP. I regret disappointing them and want to assure them that my commitment to serving and supporting them and communities remains unwavering. In fact, I'm dedicated to making an even greater positive impact in their lives, beyond what would have been possible as an MP. All I ask is for you to join TSC to receive the many benefits we have and step to achieving success in life. I'm grateful to the people of Wassa East for their kindness and support.
